Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 18 S-Class vehicles (222 platform), the front axle might be equipped with brakes which do not meet current production specifications (brake disc, brake caliper, brake pads). Nevertheless, the legal requirements regarding brake performance and brake regulating functions are still fulfilled. If equipped with a front axle brake system that has an incorrect brake specifications, vehicle maintenance might not be carried out in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will replace the front axle brake system on the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required
  on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

1. Replace front axle brake disks.

2. Replace front axle brake calipers and brakepads.

i For basic data on replacing brake caliper, see AR42.10-P-0070LF.

For basic data on changing brakepad, see AR42.10-P-1600LF.

3. Assemble in reverse order.
