Subject: SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Michelin Tire Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Michelin North America, Inc. has decided that certain MICHELIN® CrossClimate® + 225/60R17 103V XL tires fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 49 CFR 571.139. The affected tires lack the letters "DOT" as required by the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard and also lack the UTQG treadwear, traction and temperature grade markings required by 49 CFR 575.104. Michelin is recalling 32 of these tires in the United States.

The recalled tire is the MICHELIN® CrossClimate® + 225/60R17 103V XL, TIN (Tire Identification Number) HCXH03CX, Production Week and Year 4618. These tires are primarily found on passenger cars, CUV's and small SUV's.

You are receiving this letter because our records indicate that you may have purchased one or more of the recalled tires. The following chart provides the product description, TIN (Tire Identification Number) sequence identifier and TIN production period of the manufacturing population which contain the recalled tires. The TIN information is molded to the sidewall of each tire.

To find out if a tire is affected by the recall:

1. Check the TIN on the sidewall of the tire located just above the bead.

HOW TO READ THE TIN





 Only tires matching all three elements (Tire Description, TIN Sequence and TIN Production Periods) are part of this recall. If inspected tire is not the product noted below, the tire is not part of this recall.

If you have tires that match the above identifiers, contact your local authorized Michelin retailer or locate a Michelin retailer on the dealer locator at www.Michelinman.com.

It is important that all recalled tires be removed from service as soon as possible. The removed tires will be replaced with a MICHELIN® CrossClimate® + 225/60R17 103V XL that has the proper markings at no cost up until July 31, 2020. After that time the recalled tires will be processed as part of our standard prorated warranty policy.
