This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Hyundai has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your vehicle, with the VIN shown above. Hyundai is conducting a safety recall in the United States to inspect for an oil pan leak, and if necessary, replace the oil pressure switch and oil pan in certain Model Year 2011 through 2013 Hyundai Tucson vehicles equipped with 2.4 liter engines produced from May 19, 2010 to December 31, 2012 by Hyundai Motor Company at the Ulsan plant in the Republic of Korea.

What is the problem?

The subject vehicles may have an engine oil leak from the seal between the oil pan and engine block which, if left unrepaired and operated over time, could eventually lead to engine damage. A damaged engine could lead to a high-speed stall, increasing the risk of a crash. It could also increase the risk of a vehicle fire.

What will Hyundai do?

Your Hyundai Dealer will inspect for the presence of an oil pan leak and repair it as necessary. Dealers will also install an updated oil pressure switch and, if necessary based on vehicle inspection, an oil pan. The procedure will be performed at **NO CHARGE**.

What should you do?

Please contact your nearest Hyundai dealer to schedule the recall repair as soon as possible.

The actual time required to inspect your vehicle is less than one hour, however your vehicle may be needed for longer; therefore we recommend scheduling an appointment to minimize inconvenience.


