! IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL !

REPLACEMENT OF HEADSTOCK TIDY TO PREVENT MALFUNCTION OF THE TURN SIGNAL INDICATORS, HEAD LAMP AND / OR ENGINE STALL.

This notice applies to your motorcycle:

Model: Bonneville T100, Bonneville T100 Black, Bonneville T120, Bonneville T120 Black, Street Scrambler, Street Twin and Street Cup

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Triumph Motorcycles Ltd. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your motorcycle, with the VIN shown above. Triumph is conducting a safety recall to address the condition.

The reason for this recall notice: The clutch cable may contact the main harness sheath and cause damage to wiring within the main harness. If this condition occurs and remains undetected, it may lead to a loss of electrical power to various electrical circuits. As a consequence, the headlight or indicator lighting may malfunction, or the engine could stall, increasing the risk of a crash.

What Triumph Motorcycles Ltd & your dealer will do: Triumph Motorcycles Ltd has authorized your dealer to replace the original securing guide for the clutch cable and main harness, called a headstock tidy, free of charge to you including parts and labour. This repair should take less than 30 minutes. However, depending upon the dealer's work schedule, it may be necessary to make your motorcycle available for a longer period of time.

What you must do to ensure your safety: Please make an appointment with your authorized Triumph motorcycles dealer to have this important remedy performed on your motorcycle as soon as possible.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within 10 days.

If you need help: Please contact your authorized Triumph dealer should you have any questions or encounter any difficulty regarding this recall. In the event your dealer is unable to remedy your motorcycle, please contact Triumph Motorcycles America at 1-678-854-2010.

If an authorized Triumph dealer or Triumph Motorcycle America Ltd, fails or is unable to perform this remedy without charge within a reasonable amount of time, you may contact the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE., Washington, D.C., 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
