

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Dear Supreme Truck Body Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Supreme Corporation has decided that a defect exists which relates to motor vehicle safety in certain model year 2014-2016 Supreme Classic American Trolleys. Our records indicate that your vehicle(s) identified above may be affected. Supreme is conducting a safety recall to address this condition.

What is the Issue?

Certain Supreme trolleys were equipped with Ricon Corporation S or K Series Wheelchair Lifts that are subject of a recall being conducted by Ricon Corporation (NHTSA Recall No. 18E-044). According to Ricon, the lift position input cam may fail while in use. If the position input cam fails and the lift operator continues to press the "up" button on the operating pedant while the lift is occupied, the lift platform could tilt inward toward the vehicle, causing risk of injury.

What Should You Do?

Please contact your local Ricon dealer for a field modification instruction and all material required to mitigate this recall at no charge.
