## Dear Maserati Customer:

This notification is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Maserati S.p.A. and Maserati North America, Inc. (MNA), have decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 2015-2018 Model Year Maserati Granturismo vehicles and 2016-2018 Model Year Maserati Granturismo Convertible vehicles.

Maserati S.p.A. and MNA have determined that the above-described vehicles were manufactured with an airbag electronic control unit (ECU) that may have a defective power supply capacitor. The airbag ECU may inhibit a proper airbag deployment in a crash or command an inadvertent deployment of the airbag or seatbelt pretensioners. An inhibited airbag deployment in a crash or an inadvertent deployment of the airbag or seatbelt pretensioners may result in an increased risk of occupant injury.

Your Maserati Dealer will replace the airbag ECU on the affected vehicles, free of charge. Since your vehicle is among those that may be affected by the above condition, we ask you to contact any Authorized Maserati Dealer in order to arrange for this recall action to be performed to your vehicle. The repair will take approximately 2.5 hours to complete. Please prepare to leave your vehicle with the dealership to allow the dealer to complete your repairs. Your Authorized Maserati Dealers have the necessary instructions and components to remedy your vehicle.
