Dear «OWNER»:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Heartland RV (Heartland) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Heartland travel trailers. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you, however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall	On certain fifth wheel trailers the electrical connection for the air conditioning units may not be done properly. The electrical connector may not be crimped as specified. This could allow resistance and heat to build up in the connection and cause a failure which could result in property damage, personal injury, and/or death.
What we will do	Heartland will have an authorized dealer or repair center replace the bell cap connectors with yellow wire nuts and wrap them in electrical tape. This repair should take no longer than 2 hours to complete. This defect will be corrected at no expense to you, the owner.
What we need you to do	At your earliest convenience, Please contact your local dealer to set up an appointment to have this inspected and if needed corrected immediately, this service will be performed free of charge. You will need the following information for the phone call: • VIN of your travel trailer • Name, Address, and Phone Number

If you had appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Heartland by contacting the **Heartland Warranty/Service Department**.
