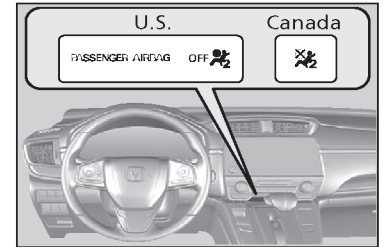

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

### WHAT IS THE REASON FOR THIS NOTICE?

Honda has decided that certain 2019 CR-V vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 208, Occupant Crash Protection, because the owner's guide contains incorrect information about the operation of the Passenger Airbag Off Indicator. The owner's guide, which is provided in your vehicle and includes basic information and instructions on technology and convenience features, incorrectly states that the indicator will not illuminate if the front passenger seat is empty. The opposite is actually true: the indicator will illuminate when the front passenger seat is empty. A vehicle occupant reviewing the owner's guide information may misunderstand when the Passenger Airbag Off Indicator should be illuminated and become confused about the operation of the passenger airbag. If the front passenger does not correctly understand how the airbag functions, they may be at an increased risk of personal injury in the event of a crash. Please note that there are no problems with the airbag system, and only the Passenger Airbag Off Indicator information in the owner's guide is incorrect.



### YOUR VEHICLE IS ALSO ELIGIBLE FOR A SEPARATE AND UNRELATED PRODUCT UPDATE CAMPAIGN

The owner's guide also does not include vehicle rollover information required for your CR-V. The missing information would have advised the driver of a higher rollover risk, and to wear their seat belt to reduce the chance of injury or death in a rollover crash, because your CR-V is higher off the ground than a passenger vehicle.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO?

Enclosed are two stickers and instructions on how to apply the stickers in your owner's guide: 1) correct Passenger Airbag Off Indicator information, and 2) vehicle rollover information required for your CR-V. Please follow the enclosed instructions and apply the two stickers in your owner's guide. If you prefer, your local Honda dealer can apply the stickers, free of charge. If you have recently visited a Honda automobile dealer, this action may have already been completed. If you are not the only driver of this vehicle, please advise all other drivers and passengers of this important information.

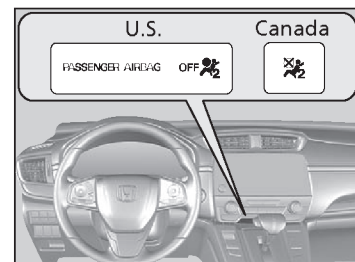

### ¿CUÁL ES EL MOTIVO DE ESTA NOTIFICACIÓN?

Honda ha determinado que ciertos vehículos CR-V 2019 fallaron con el cumplimiento de la Norma Federal de Seguridad para Vehículos de Motor No. 208, "Occupant Crash Protection" (Protección de los ocupantes en choques) debido a que la guía del propietario contiene información incorrecta sobre el funcionamiento del indicador de apagado de la bolsa de aire del lado del pasajero. La guía del propietario, la cual se coloca en su vehículo e incluye información básica e instrucciones sobre funciones tecnológicas y de conveniencia, indica incorrectamente que el indicador no se iluminará si el asiento del lado del pasajero delantero está vacío. Lo opuesto es realmente lo verdadero: el indicador se iluminará cuando el asiento del lado del pasajero delantero está vacío. Un ocupante del vehículo que revise la información de la guía del propietario puede entender mal cuando el indicador de apagado de la bolsa de aire del lado del pasajero debe estar iluminado y confundirse sobre el funcionamiento de la bolsa de aire del lado del pasajero. Si el pasajero delantero no entiende correctamente cómo funciona la bolsa de aire, puede estar en mayor riesgo de lesión personal en caso de un choque. Por favor tenga en cuenta que no hay problemas con el sistema de la bolsa de aire y que solamente la información del indicador de apagado de la bolsa de aire del lado del pasajero en la guía del propietario está incorrecta.

Higher ground clearance has many advantages for off-highway driving. It allows you to travel over bumps, obstacles, and rough terrain. It also provides good visibility so you can anticipate problems earlier. These advantages come at some cost. Because your vehicle is taller and rides higher off the ground, it has a higher center gravity making it more susceptible to tipping or roll over if you make abrupt turns. Utility vehicles have a significantly higher rollover rate than other types of vehicles. In a rollover crash, an unbelted person is significantly more likely to die than a person wearing a seat belt. 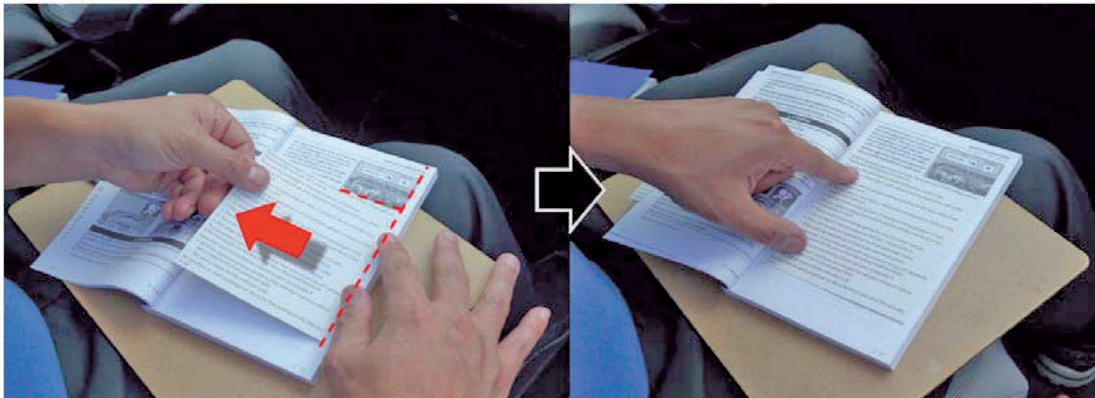
