

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Safety Recall: NHTSA 19V-734/Transport Canada 2019-524 Safety Advisory: October 23, 2019

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Airstream has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2019 and 2020 Model Year Airstream Atlas Motor Homes. As a result, Airstream is conducting a safety recall.

Reason for this recall	The affected motor homes could have SH1 Breaker Terminals which may have been wired incorrectly, and may cause improper overcurrent protection for the 12V circuits powered by this breaker block. This may cause the wire to become overheated and create the potential for fire which could result in property damage or personal injury. A fire could result even if the vehicle is unattended.
What we will do	The remedy is to perform an inspection of the 12V terminal block. If the terminal block has wires going to the incorrect breakers, the wires will need to be relocated to the correct breakers. The remedy should take approximately 30 minutes to perform. This will be done at no cost to the customer.
What we need you to do	You should contact your selling dealer immediately to schedule a service appointment to have the defect repaired in your vehicle. If you have questions concerning this recall or if you need any assistance, please contact the Airstream Customer Service Department by mail at Airstream, P.O. If you have had the appropriate repairs completed prior to receipt of this recall notice, and if you incurred any direct cost in connection with obtaining such repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement from Airstream by contacting the Airstream Customer Service Department .

If after contacting Airstream Customer Service you are still not satisfied we have done our best to remedy this situation, you may also submit a written complaint to: Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE, Washington, DC 20590. Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
