Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2019-2020 Keystone Hideout Travel Trailers. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall.

***Reason for  
this recall***

It has been decided that the vehicles in the recall population are missing the Special Transportation Provision warning label (AD-96) in the garage area as outlined in 6.4.6.9 of the 2018 NFPA 1192 code book. Vehicles and equipment powered by internal combustion engines and placed in recreational vehicles can cause carbon monoxide poisoning or asphyxiation, which could result in death or serious injury. The flammable liquids used to power these items can cause a fire or explosion, which can result in death or serious injury. The vehicles included in the recall are:
