Subject: Freightliner Cascadia Steering Wheel Airbags

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC (DTNA), on behalf of its Freightliner Trucks Division, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on specific Freightliner Cascadia vehicles manufactured December 5, 2017, through January 9, 2019.

On specific vehicles, an unintended deployment of the steering wheel air bag may occur under certain circumstances. The unintended deployment of a steering wheel air bag may be caused when certain electrical grounds are improperly assembled. This may cause risk of injury to the driver and potential increase in the risk of a crash.

This letter is to inform you of an upcoming Recall to correct the issue noted above. Daimler Trucks is currently validating the repair and securing replacement parts. There is no action for you to take at this time. You will be notified by mail when the Recall repair is available.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days. If you are a subsequent stage manufacturer, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to your distributors and retail outlets within five working days.
