IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: ICU3S Shift Position Display

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC (DTNA), on behalf of its Freightliner Trucks Division, has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists on specific Freightliner Cascadia vehicles manufactured January 4, 2019, through January 26, 2019, and equipped with a DT12 automated manual transmission and ICU3S instrument cluster.

On certain vehicles, the gear position indicator light on the cluster may not match the gear shift lever position. The display can indicate 'N' when the shifter is set to 'D' or 'R,' vehicles may move while shifter is set to 'D' or 'R,' however the cluster display will remain 'N,' potentially leading to an increased risks of injury or crash.

This is the first of two notices you will receive regarding the subject. The letter is to inform you of an upcoming Recall to correct the issue noted above Daimler Trucks is currently validating the repair. There is no action for you to take at this time.

The second notice will inform you when the remedy is available. **When you receive the second notice,** please contact your authorized Daimler Trucks North America dealer to schedule the Recall for your vehicle.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s), which appears on the Recall Notice, please return the notice in the postage-paid envelope with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner.
