Update: Volvo Trucks Sleeper Bunk Window Safety Defect Subject:

As announced in SBN19-030 and SRA-V19-02, a safety defect has been identified on certain 2018-2020 Volvo VNL 740, VNL 760 and VNX 740 models built between January 31, 2017 through January 11, 2019 due to the potential for the sleeper bunk windows to detach and fall from the vehicle.

⊠CAN

Volvo Trucks North America is working to have repair instructions and parts kits available for the window repair. A special tool is required to complete the repair, and is currently being manufactured. Work is being done with the supplier to expedite this tool. Another update will be provided in the beginning of August.

Volvo Trucks North America has received no reports of personal injury as a result of this defect. Therefore, Volvo Trucks considers this a proactive measure to protect the public and our customers from any potential risks associated with this defect.
