

2020 MY Kia Telluride Seatbelt Chronology
Basis of Safety Defect Determination 573.6(c)(6)

July 26, 2019	Through normal vehicle inspection procedures, Kia Motors Manufacturing Georgia (KMMG) identifies a Telluride vehicle manufactured for sale in U.S. with a non-automatic locking retractor (non-ALR) seatbelt assembly installed.
July 29-August 5, 2019	KMMG and supplier investigate. Determined that seatbelt assemblies designed for Middle East vehicles may have been inadvertently installed in the driver, front passenger, second and/or third row seats of a small number of Telluride vehicles manufactured for sale in the U.S.
August 8, 2019	KMC makes decision to conduct recall. No customer complaints, warranty claims, or injury.
