#### **Chronology:**

August 21, 2020: Honda Manufacturing Alabama reported two tires which experienced rapid air loss on Honda's plant property.

August 24, 2020: A CTA representative from the Mt. Vernon plant travelled to the Honda plant to assess the situation. Initial findings indicated potential mounting damage as the cause of the failures. The two tires and

rims were shipped to CTA's Plant Mt. Vernon for further investigation and arrived on August 26, 2020.

September 11, 2020: Tire analysis revealed that both tires had an overcure condition. The Mt. Vernon plant immediately started a detailed analysis of tire curing data. During that investigation, CTA discovered that three additional tires were cured beyond the specification limit and shipped to a Honda plant. Containment actions were immediately triggered at CTA and the Honda locations.

September 13, 2020: CTA discovered that eight additional tires were cured beyond the specification limit and shipped to a Honda plant.

September 18, 2020: CTA's Product Integrity Committee convened and determined that the manufacturing defect presents an unreasonable risk to safety and made the decision to initiate this recall. CTA is not aware of any claims of personal injury or death involving these tires.

#### **Description of Remedy:**

Description of Remedy Program: CTA will conduct a safety recall campaign to replace the subject tires that have been sold, either as original equipment tires, replacement tires, or are in dealer inventories. All known customers, distributors, dealers and independent outlets will receive notification of the campaign, instructions on how to identify the subject tires, information regarding removal of the subject tires from service, and instructions on the return/disposal of affected tires. CTA will offer to reimburse the replacement cost for any customer who, prior to this campaign, replaced these tires due to the condition described above.

How Remedy Component Differs "The remedy tires will be offered under the same product article number from Recalled Component: from DOT production weeks not affected by the condition. Article No. 0354249 - 245/50R20 102H - Continental CrossContact LX Sport "
