November 3, 2015 Consent Order in EA15-001. Subaru is submitting this DIR (Zone B) in accordance with section 46 of Coordinated Remedy Order.

Subaru intends to implement the "other" reporting category for removed vehicles in Quarterly Reporting as permitted in the Third Amendment to the Coordinated Remedy Order ("ACRO"), Paragraphs 45 through 49. As a condition of the ACRO, all affected vehicles will remain active, or "live," across Subaru's data systems such that any search of "other" removed VINs will return an open recall status. For this reason, the number of potentially involved vehicles in this report will remain the same. Future changes to overall Total Removed counts, including "other," will be reflected in quarterly reporting.

Description of the Safety Risk: Activation of a non-desiccated ammonium nitrate inflator with degraded

propellant may result in an inflator rupture. An inflator rupture may cause metal fragments to pass through the air bag and into the vehicle interior at

high speed, which may result in injury or death to vehicle occupants.

Description of the Cause: Based upon Takata's investigation to date, the propellant wafers in some of the

subject inflators may degrade over time, which could lead to overaggressive combustion in the event the air bag is activated. Overly aggressive combustion creates excessive internal pressure when the inflator is activated, which may

cause the inflator body to rupture.

November 3, 2015 - NHTSA and Takata entered into a Consent Order in EA15-001 to resolve issues raised in that investigation, to mitigate and control risks of harm, and to promote public safety.

May 4, 2016 - NHTSA and Takata entered into an Amendment to the November 3, 2015 Consent Order. As stated in that Amendment, on the basis of testing and analysis conducted by Takata and by independent research organizations, NHTSA has concluded that, "at some point in the future all non-desiccated frontal Takata PSAN inflators will reach a threshold level of degradation that could result in the inflator becoming unreasonably dangerous." As a result of this conclusion, and pursuant to Paragraph 29 of the November 3, 2015 Consent Order, NHTSA ordered Takata to file certain defect information reports ("DIR"), in accordance with the schedule set forth in Paragraph 14 of the Amendment.

May 16, 2016 - As specified in that schedule, Takata submitted the DIR.

May 20, 2016 - Subaru has determined to launch recall according to Section 46 of Coordinated Remedy Order.

January 3, 2017 - As specified in that schedule, Takata submitted the DIR.

January 10, 2017 - Subaru has determined to launch recall according to Section 32 of 3rd amended Coordinated Remedy Order.

January 2, 2018 - As specified in that schedule, Takata submitted the DIR.

January 9, 2018 - Subaru has determined to launch recall according to Section 32 of 3rd amended Coordinated Remedy Order.

January 2, 2019 - As specified in that schedule, TK Global submitted the DIR.

January 8, 2019 - Subaru has determined to launch recall according to Section 32 of 3rd amended Coordinated Remedy Order.

Description of Remedy Program: The remedy plan calls for dealers to replace the passenger airbag inflator.

How Remedy Component Differs The remedy components do not contain PSAN. from Recalled Component:

The recalled component is "AIR B MOD ASSY P" (part number: 98279SC010 for Forester, 98279AE00A for 2003-2004MY Legacy/Outback and 2003-2006MY Baja, 98279AG00A for 2005-2009MY Legacy/Outback, 98279AJ02A for 2010-2014MY Legacy/Outback, 98279FE000 for 2004-2005MY Impreza/WRX, 98279FE160 for 2006-2007MY Impreza/WRX, 98279FG010 for 2008-2011MY Impreza and 2008-2014MY WRX).

Identify How/When Recall Condition As for Impreza from 2012MY, Forester from 2014MY, and WRX, Legacy/ was Corrected in Production: Outback from 2015MY, parts which are different from Takata Non-Desiccated Frontal Passenger-side Air Bag Inflators containing Phase Stabilized Ammonium Nitrate are being installed in their production. Baja and Saab 9-2X ended production, with 2006MY as the last.
