Description of the Defect: The fuel pump provides a continuous supply of fuel to the engine via the

pump's jet nozzle. During production of the fuel pump's jet nozzle housing, a plastic burr may remain after the molding process potentially blocking the nozzle. A blocked nozzle can result in an insufficient supply of fuel to the engine. An insufficient supply of fuel to the engine can result in a loss of motive

power increasing the risk of a crash.
