Affected VINs will be flagged in VMI as "OPEN" on August 28, 2020.

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has deter on certain MY17-19 C-Class (205 platform), E-Class (213 platform), S-Class (222 platfor Coupe/Convertible (238 platform) and CLS-Class (257 platform) vehicles, the seat be system does not meet current production specifications. If the driver or passenger sear fastened, the seat belt warning would not warn the driver as intended by means of warning lamp in the instrument cluster and an audible warning tone, but only with a practivated warning lamp. Thus, the driver would not receive the full scope of intended to the event of an unfastened seatbelt. An unfastened seatbelt increases the risk of injury in of a crash. The customer may be made aware of the issue by the absence of the blinking lamp and the audible warning tone if the vehicle is driven without the seat belt fastener.		
What We're Doing	MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will update the (SCN) -Coding of the instrument cluster on the affected vehicles.

Given this notice, it is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to sell or lease any new MY17-19 C-Class, E-Class, S-Class, E-Class Coupe/Convertible and CLS-Class vehicles in dealer inventory covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired. Once the remedy is available, the vehicles will be flagged as "OPEN" and Work Instructions will be available in Star TekInfo. Once the repair is complete the vehicle may be sold or leased.

Loaner and demonstrator vehicles may continue to be driven, but must not be retailed until repaired.

Additionally, given this notice, it is <u>a violation of Federal Law</u> for <u>car rental companies</u> to rent MY17-19 C-Class, E-Class, E-Class, E-Class Coupe/Convertible and CLS-Class vehicles covered by this notification until the vehicle has been repaired.

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain MY17-19 C-Class (205 platform), E-Class (213 platform), S-Class (222 platform), EClass Coupe/Convertible (238 platform) and CLS-Class (257 platform) vehicles, the seat belt warning system does not meet current production specifications. If the driver or passenger seat belt is not fastened, the seat belt warning would not warn the driver as intended by means of a blinking warning lamp in the instrument cluster and an audible warning tone, but only with a permanently activated warning lamp. Thus, the driver would not receive the full scope of intended warnings in the event of an unfastened seatbelt. An unfastened seatbelt increases the risk of injury in the event of a crash. The customer may be made aware of the issue by the absence of the blinking warning lamp and the audible warning tone if the vehicle is driven without the seat belt fastened. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will update the (SCN) -Coding of the instrument cluster on the affected vehicles.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required
  on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

Approximately 56 vehicles are involved.
