



New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – W62

FCA US LLC (FCA US) has announced a safety recall on certain 2018 through 2020 Model Year (LD) Dodge Charger Pursuit (Police) vehicles.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

The Body Control Module (BCM) software on some of the above vehicles may not meet Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 111 which requires that the rear visibility system default to the rearview image being visible, at the beginning of each backing event, regardless of any modifications to the field of view that the driver had previously selected. Suspect vehicles are equipped with a "stealth mode" that disables the rearview image when selected and the system does not default to displaying the rearview image at the beginning of the next backing event after being engaged. The vehicle operator will notice that the rearview image is not displayed if attempting to reference the image while backing. If this warning is not heeded, backing without verifying it is safe to do so could lead to an increased risk of injury to people outside the vehicle.

SERVICE ACTION

FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to update the BCM software to disable stealth mode when the vehicle is shifted into REVERSE. The remedy for this condition is not currently available. Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established communication methods. This recall is estimated to launch in 4th Quarter of 2020.
