Issue: The fuel rail bolts on affected vehicles may become loose over time. This can result in a fuel leak. Leaking fuel, in the presence of an ignition source, may result in a vehicle fire.

Precautions If this condition is present in the vehicle, owners may notice a fuel odor or see leaking fuel coming from the engine compartment. Owners experiencing this condition with their vehicle are advised to contact an authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to make arrangements to have the vehicle inspected/repaired.

New Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: It is a violation of federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied. By law, dealers must correct, prior to delivery for sale or lease, any vehicle that fails to comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or that contains a defect relating to motor vehicle safety.

Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Inventory: Dealers should not deliver any pre-owned vehicles in their inventory which are involved in a safety or compliance recall until the defect has been remedied.
