This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in 116, 2020-2021 model year Xpeditor chassis. These chassis were manufactured between June 3, 2019, and October 2, 2020, with non-sequential serial numbers in the range of 231022 through 234626, accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective April 5, 2022.

MODELS Autocar Xpeditor MY 2020-2021
AFFECTED:

COMPONENTS The engine ground cable is too short and may fail.
AFFECTED:

SAFETY If the ground cable fails, the engine may stall and not re-start without warning,
DEFECTS AND increasing the risk of personal injury, property damage or a crash.
POTENTIAL
RISKS:

REPAIR The ground cable will be replaced at no charge to the owner.
REQUIRED:

REPAIR VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on
AVAILABLE: April 5, 2022, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the Warranty system.

REMINDER: It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
