Re: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2013-2015 ILX and 2013 ILX Hybrid Driveshaft Failure

On December 10, 2020, Acura notified NHTSA of a stop sale and safety recall for certain 2013-2015 ILX and 2013 ILX Hybrid vehicles for improperly manufactured driveshafts that may corrode when driven under certain road conditions, increasing the risk of a crash. Refer to your eResponsibility report or do an iN VIN **status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

Failure to repair a vehicle as necessary prior to sale may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits.

BACKGROUND

Due to improper manufacturing processes, the paint coating on the driveshaft may peel and chip over time, exposing the bare driveshaft. Exposure of the driveshaft to sodium chloride, a snow melting/road de-icing agent used predominantly in the "Salt Belt" regions of the country, may cause it to corrode. Under a high torque condition, a corroded drive haft may break, rendering the vehicle unmovable or increasing the possibility it may roll while in Park.

REPAIR

Repair procedures are currently unavailable at launch. We will notify you when repair procedures become available.

PARTS

Parts are currently unavailable at launch. We will notify you when parts become available.

TOOLS

There are no special tools needed for this recall.

SERVICE BULLETIN

Placeholder service bulletin 20-051, *Safety Recall: 2013-15 ILX and 2013 ILX Hybrid Driveshaft Failure*, has been posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of December 11, 2020.

CLIENT NOTIFICATION

Acura expects to begin client notification in early February 2021.

As always, be sure to do an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
