Please be advised that as of today, April 15, 2021, parts are available for the 2013 ILX Hybrid model through the controlled parts ordering system under the following revised service bulletin:

- 21-018, *Safety Recall: 2013-2015 ILX and 2013 ILX Hybrid Driveshaft Inspection*

This bulletin includes inspection, parts, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

SUMMARY

On December 10, 2020, Acura notified NHTSA of a stop sale and safety recall for certain 2013-2015 ILX and 2013 ILX Hybrid vehicles for improperly manufactured driveshafts that may corrode when driven under certain road conditions, increasing the risk of a crash. Refer to your eResponsibility report or do an iN VIN **status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

Failure to repair a vehicle as necessary prior to sale may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits.

As always, be sure to do an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
