

Advance Notice - Safety Recall 69BC / Driver Frontal Airbag (Takata SDI-D Inflator)

Issue:	Volkswagen and the NHTSA reviewed findings from various sources, including but not limited to a study from TK Global (the successor to TK Holdings, Inc.), on the safety and service life of desiccated Takata airbag inflators. Volkswagen's internal testing of SDI-D returned parts indicated better performance than the results of other studies, including TK Global's and did not identify any defects. Nevertheless, in consultation with the NHTSA regarding the Agency's evaluation of such sources, and out of an abundance of caution, Volkswagen agrees to recall certain vehicles specified herein that contain SDI-D phase-stabilized ammonium nitrate ("PSAN") airbag inflators, which are desiccated inflators containing 2004 propellant.				
	The Takata SDI-D driver frontal airbag inflators installed in the recalled vehicles currently do not pose an unreasonable risk to motor vehicle safety to drivers of affected vehicles. Based on its prior conversations with NHTSA, Volkswagen understands that the Agency is concerned that after additional time, the airbag inflator may not perform properly in the event of a crash. Out of an abundance of caution, Volkswagen agrees to recall certain vehicles specified herein that contain SDI-D phase-stabilized ammonium nitrate ("PSAN") airbag inflators, which are desiccated inflators containing 2004 propellant.
