This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. BMW AG has decided that certain dealer accessory brake fluid reservoir covers (for Model Year 2018-2020 BMW R1250 (R, RS, RT, GS, GS Adventure), RnineT, and RnineT (Pure, Racer, Scrambler) motorcycles) fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 122 (Motorcycle Brake Systems). Our records indicate that you are the owner of a potentially affected cover.

Why are we contacting you?

We are pleased to inform you that we are ready to perform this important Non-Compliance Recall. If you purchased a dealer accessory brake fluid reservoir cover for your motorcycle, please contact your authorized BMW motorcycle dealer immediately to schedule an appointment. Visit www.bmwmotorcycles.com/dealer to locate your nearest authorized BMW motorcycle dealer.

What could happen?

The stamped text on the optional (milled and color-specific) brake fluid reservoir may not meet a Federal requirement. If the text was misunderstood, it could lead to an improper maintenance procedure.

If you are not the only rider of this motorcycle, please advise all other riders of this important information.

What will BMW do?

The brake fluid reservoir cover will be replaced for free which should take about 30 minutes.

What if the current motorcycle ownership information is incorrect?

You can update motorcycle ownership and contact information by completing the enclosed postage-paid card. If you are a motorcycle lessor, Federal Regulations require you to forward this notice to your lessee within ten days.
