**IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE**

(NHTSA Recall Number: 20T005)

April 24, 2020

Dear Sentury Tire Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Sentury Tire USA has determined that the tires listed in the chart below may fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 139, New pneumatic radial tires for light vehicles. Our records indicate that you may have purchased one of the potentially affected tires.

**What Is the Problem?**

Due to a manufacturing issue, the tires may exhibit a reduced margin of performance durability. Tires that have a reduced margin of durability are more likely to develop sidewall separation, increasing the risk of a crash.

**What Tires Are Covered?**

This recall involves the following tires:

**What Will Sentury Tire Do?**

- If the dealer’s inspection verifies that you have a tire or tires within the affected range, the tire or tires will be replaced, mounted, and if needed, balanced at no cost to you through November 30, 2020. After November 30, 2020, tires will be replaced at a pro-rated value determined by remaining tread depth. If tires

manufactured by Sentury Tire are not available at the time of the inspection, the affected tire(s) will be replaced with tire(s) from a comparable brand using the same size and load rating as required by the vehicle manufacturer. The time required to determine if you tire(s) is subject to the recall is just a few minutes, and approximately up to thirty (30) minutes per tire if replacement is required.

### **What Should You Do?**

- In the interest of safety for both yourself and your passengers, please return any recalled tires along with this letter to the location where you purchased the tire(s) so that they can be replaced under this recall.

### **What If You Have Already Paid to Have This Situation Corrected?**
