

# IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Foreign Tire Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Foreign Tire Sales, Inc., has determined that a safety defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain **Otani commercial truck** tires.

## REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The recall is due to a manufacturing defect in which cracks may develop in the tread which could lead to tread separation and a sudden loss of air pressure, increasing the risk of a crash.
