If the diffuser separates from the inflator during deployment, RRAB performance may be degraded, which could increase risk of injury to occupants in a crash.
What will we do?	Your GM dealer will replace suspect side RRAB modules. This service will be performed for you at no charge . Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual service correction time of up to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ hours.
