REPAIR PROCEDURE

1. Remove the upper tailgate trim, both side tailgate trims, the pull pocket, and the lower tailgate trim.



2. Remove the three nuts holding the rear license trim.



3. Carefully pull up the rear license trim to release the end clips and to release the pins of the clips from the remaining grommets. Disconnect the connector and using a flat head screwdriver carefully remove the rearview camera.



- 4. Install the new rearview camera in the reverse order of removal.
- 5. Install the parts in the reverse order of removal.
- 6. Make sure the rearview camera is operating properly.
