VOLUNTARY RECALL CAMPAIGN 2019 TITAN AND TITAN XD; LED HEADLAMPS

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2019 Titan and Titan XD (A61)

APPLIED SYSTEM: LED Headlamps

Check Service COMM or Dealer Business Systems (DBS) National Service History to confirm campaign eligibility.

INTRODUCTION

Nissan is conducting this voluntary recall campaign on certain specific model year 2019 Titan and Titan XD vehicles to inspect, and if applicable, replace the LED headlamps. This service will be performed at no charge to the customer for parts or labor.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Nissan has assigned identification number PC751 to this campaign. This number must appear on all communication and documentation of any nature dealing with this campaign.

DEALER RESPONSIBILITY

It is the dealer's responsibility to check Service COMM or Dealer Business Systems (DBS) National Service History for the campaign status on each vehicle falling within the range of this voluntary recall which for any reason enters the service department. This includes vehicles purchased from private parties or presented by transient (tourist) owners and vehicles in a dealer's inventory. Federal law requires that new vehicles in dealer inventory which are the subject of a recall must be corrected prior to sale. Failure to do so can result in civil penalties by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. While federal law applies only to new vehicles, Nissan strongly encourages dealers to correct any used vehicles in their inventory before they are retailed.

Nissan Bulletins are intended for use by qualified technicians, not 'do-it-yourselfers'. Qualified technicians are properly trained individuals who have the equipment, tools, safety instruction, and know-how to do a job properly and safely. **NOTE:** If you believe that a described condition may apply to a particular vehicle, DO NOT assume that it does. See your Nissan dealer to determine if this applies to your vehicle.

1. Open the hood.








Figure 3 Figure 4

 - To replace the headlamp(s), refer to the ESM: DRIVER CONTROLS >
 EXTERIOR LIGHTING SYSTEM > LED HEADLAMP > REMOVAL
 AND INSTALLATION > FRONT COMBINATION LAMP > Removal
 and Installation.
 - If ALL laser etch markings are correct, close the hood and go to the **CLAIMS INFORMATION** on page 5.
