## Hyundai Issues Important Safety Recall

Anti-Lock Brake System (ABS) Module - Remedy is Available

#### Additional Information

The subject vehicles are equipped with an Anti-Lock Brake System ("ABS") module that remains energized when the vehicle is turned off. If moisture enters the electrical circuit of the ABS module a short circuit could develop. If a short circuit occurs inside the ABS module, there could be an increased risk of an engine compartment fire, even when the car is turned off, increasing the risk of injury. The short circuit does not affect brake system operation.
