This is an important Safety Recall. The remedy will be performed FREE OF CHARGE to you.

# **IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL (Interim Notice)**

Certain 2019 - 2020 Model Year Porsche Cayenne Turbo,
Cayenne Turbo Coupe and Cayenne Turbo S Hybrid Coupe Vehicles
Fuel Line Quick Connector may leak

Dear Mr.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the <u>National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.</u> Porsche has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2019-2020 Porsche Cayenne vehicles.

You received this notice because our records, which are based primarily on state registration and title data, indicate that you are the current owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

#### What is the issue?

On some of the affected vehicles, the fuel line quick connector may not have met the design specification, potentially resulting in a fuel leak under certain conditions. A fuel leak, in the presence of an ignition source, can increase the risk of a fire.

### What should you do?

Please wait for our follow up letter to bring your vehicle in for a remedy. In the meantime, if you smell fuel odor, please immediately contact any authorized Porsche dealer to schedule an appointment and park outdoors until the remedy is performed.

# What will Porsche do?

The fuel line, including quick connector will be replaced with a replacement part on all potentially affected vehicles. <u>These</u> repairs will be covered free of charge. At a future date, once all parts are available in a sufficient quantity, Porsche will send an additional letter asking that you contact your authorized Porsche dealer for completion of this recall.

# What if you are not the owner or operator of this vehicle?

If you are the lessor and registered owner of the vehicle identified in this action, the law requires you to forward this letter immediately via first-class mail to the lessee within ten days of receipt.

If you have changed your address or sold the vehicle, please fill out the enclosed prepaid Owner Reply Card and mail it to us so we can update our records.

If you believe that the dealer or Porsche has failed or is unable to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable amount of time, you may file a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20590 or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153) or go to: <a href="http://www.safercar.gov">http://www.safercar.gov</a>.
