Description of the Defect :	This safety recall involves the head restraints installed in the outboard seating positions in the second row. Vehicles may have been equipped with head restraints of a design configuration intended for a different vehicle model. Specifically, the head restraints may not contain the specific number of notches on the attachment rods that are inserted into the seat back.

#### **Chronology** :

On February 15, 2021, BMW was informed by the seat supplier that during an end-of-line inspection, it was noticed that a head restraint of a certain design configuration may have been installed in a second row outboard seat intended for a different vehicle model.

On February 22nd, it was determined from a review of supplier production records that, during a production run on February 2nd, a number of head restraints may have been produced which subsequently entered the

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supply chain for a different seating configuration. Further reviews indicated that second row outboard seats containing these head restraints may have been installed during vehicle assembly.

An engineering review was performed, and testing was conducted. Although FMVSS 202 requirements were met, testing indicated that in certain frontal collisions in which the severity of the crash exceeded NHTSA requirements, the head restraint could detach from the seat.

Vehicle assembly information and supplier production records were used to determine the production date range of potentially affected vehicles.

On March 3, 2021, BMW decided to conduct a voluntary safety recall.

BMW has not received any reports, nor is BMW otherwise aware, of any accidents or injuries related to this issue.

#### **Description of Remedy :**

Description of Remedy Program :	The head restraints will be inspected and, if necessary, replaced.
	Owners will be notified by First Class mail and instructed to take their vehicle to an authorized BMW center to have the remedy performed for free. If this condition was noticed on a potentially affected vehicle prior to this recall, the remedy would be covered by the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty program. Therefore, reimbursement for a pre-notification remedy re Part 573.13 and Part 577.11 is not necessary.
