Description of the Defect: General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety

exists in certain 2010–2015 and 2017 model year Buick Enclave vehicles; 2010–2019 model year Chevrolet Traverse vehicles; and 2011–2016 model year GMC Acadia vehicles. One or two of the weld nuts that secure the right or left roof-rail airbag to the vehicle might be damaged, out of position, or missing.

Description of the Cause: Certain stampings associated with the connection of the roof-rail airbag to the

vehicle contained damaged, out of position, or missing weld nuts. These

conditions were identified during the vehicle-assembly process but the repairs

to the roof-rail airbag weld nuts may not have been performed or may have been performed improperly.

Chronology:

In October 2020, a third-party vehicle repair business contacted GM requesting repair assistance on a 2018 Buick Enclave. After removing the headliner to attempt to repair a sunroof water leak, the repair shop identified two fasteners that were not installed and one missing weld nut at one of the interfaces that attaches the roof-rail airbag (RRAB) to the vehicle. A GM brand quality manager submitted a Speak Up For Safety (SUFS) report on October 21, 2020.

After identifying the SUFS vehicle as having had rework performed during the manufacturing process, GM conducted additional analysis to attempt to determine whether other vehicles might have been shipped from LDT with unrepaired RRAB fasteners. In late January 2021, GM identified 12 other vehicles that were flagged for repair or rework during assembly at LDT for a missing or out of position weld nut at a RRAB interface. Based on this analysis, GM opened a formal product investigation on February 9, 2021.

GM's product investigation identified 108 vehicles in the U.S. that, according to LDT's repair records, may be missing one or two RRAB fasteners based on offline rework performed. Using CAE analysis, GM's investigation also confirmed that missing fasteners can adversely impact RRAB crash performance in certain crash scenarios.

On April 1, 2021, GM's Safety and Field Action Decision Authority decided to conduct a safety recall. GM is not

aware of any accidents or injuries associated with this condition.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Dealers will inspect roof-rail airbag attachments and provide or replace

any found to be missing, damaged or out of position.

Pursuant to 577.11, GM will provide reimbursement to owners for repairs

according to the plan submitted on May 17, 2019.

How Remedy Component Differs Weld nuts that are found to missing, damaged or out of position will be from Recalled Component: replaced with non-welded fasteners that provide equivalent performance.

Identify How/When Recall Condition In November 2020, after the discovery of the SUFS vehicle, GM's LDT was Corrected in Production: facility implemented additional quality control checks for all RRAB

fastener-related repairs.
