the door panels to part opened, even if a force is applied on them

Description of the Safety Risk: If the service door is not adjusted correctly and the mechanism misaligns,

occupants may not be able to open the service door using the emergency release handle, preventing occupants from using this exit to evacuate the vehicle in case of emergency. The exterior emergency release handle may also

not allow people to open the service door from outside the vehicle,,

increasing the risks of injury in case of a fire in the passenger compartment.
