Description of Noncompliance :

	Certain 2021 MTT9GTM (Tracer 900 GT) motorcycles, approximately 16, may have an incorrect VIN printed on the vehicle certification label. During assembly workers inadvertently only confirmed the last few characters of the stamped VIN with the printed VIN on the vehicle certification label instead if confirming the complete 17 digit VINs.

Description of the Safety Risk :	The official stamped VIN is correct, the issue is that the printed VIN on the vehicle certification label may not match. With an incorrect VI label, the customer may not recognize if their vehicle is involved in a safety recall, and may not get the remedy performed. Which could increase the risk of injury, fire, or a crash.
Description of the Cause :	Factory worker failed to compare all 17 digits of VIN with the 17 digits of the printed vehicle certification label.
