This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in 60, 2020-2021 model year Legend (DC) chassis manufactured between June 13, 2019, and September 30, 2020, with non-sequential serial numbers between 230891 and 234451, accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective May 26, 2022.

The steering column tilt cable may contact the steering shaft.

SAFETY DEFECTS AND POTENTIAL If the steering column tilt cable contacts the steering shaft, the shaft could bind and cause a sudden increase in steering effort, increasing the risk of personal injury,

property damage or a crash.

REPAIR REQUIRED:

RISKS:

The steering column tilt cable will be re-routed and secured at no charge to the owner.

REPAIR AVAILABLE:

VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on May 26, 2022, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the Warranty

system.

REMINDER: It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice

unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to

violations of this law.
