This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in 60, 2020-2021 model year Legend (DC) chassis manufactured between June 13, 2019, and September 30, 2020, with non-sequential serial numbers between 230891 and 234451, accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective May 26, 2022.

**MODELS** Autocar Legend (DC) MY 2020-2021  
**AFFECTED:**

**COMPONENTS** The steering column tilt cable may contact the steering shaft.  
**AFFECTED:**

**SAFETY** If the steering column tilt cable contacts the steering shaft, the shaft could bind and  
**DEFECTS AND** cause a sudden increase in steering effort, increasing the risk of personal injury,  
**POTENTIAL** property damage or a crash.  
**RISKS:**

**REPAIR** The steering column tilt cable will be re-routed and secured at no charge to the owner.  
**REQUIRED:**

**REPAIR** VIN profiles in the Autocar Warranty System will be updated to show the open recall on  
**AVAILABLE:** May 26, 2022, and a spreadsheet of the affected VINs will be available in the Warranty system.

**REMINDER:** It is a violation of Federal law to sell or lease a vehicle covered by this recall notice unless the recall remedy has been completed. Substantial civil penalties apply to violations of this law.
