

## PARTS AND SERVICE BULLETIN UPDATE

Please be advised that as of today, April 16, 2021, parts are available for the 2019 ILX, 2019-2020 MDX, 2019-2020 MDX Sport Hybrid and 2019-2020 TLX 2WD models through the controlled parts ordering system under the following service bulletins:

- 21-012, Safety Recall: 2019 ILX Fuel Pump Motor
- 21-013, Safety Recall: 2019-20 MDX and MDX Sport Hybrid Fuel Pump Motor
- 21-015, Safety Recall: 2019-20 TLX 2WD Fuel Pump Motor

These bulletins include parts, repair, and warranty information related to this recall.

## **SUMMARY**

On March 25, 2021, Acura notified NHTSA of a stop sale and safety recall for certain 2019 ILX, 2019-2020 MDX, 2019-2020 MDX Sport Hybrid, 2019-2020 RDX, and 2019-2020 TLX units for fuel pump modules manufactured with defective impellers. A defective impeller may cause the fuel pump to become inoperative which could prevent the engine from starting or stall the engine while driving, increasing the risk of a crash. Refer to your eResponsibility report or do an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.

Failure to repair a vehicle as necessary prior to sale may subject your dealership to claims or lawsuits.

As always, be sure to do an iN VIN status inquiry for all vehicles passing through your dealership to determine eligibility for any open campaigns.
