**Re: 2021 CBR1000RR-R (SP) STOP SALE NOTICE – REAR CUSHION CONNECTING PLATE**

Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is issuing a Stop Sale Notice for **CERTAIN** 2021 CBR1000RR-R (SP) motorcycles to inspect the rear cushion connecting plate. It is possible this part was installed in the wrong direction at the factory. An incorrectly installed part may cause the cushion connecting plate to break, increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

**Effective immediately, you MUST NOT SELL any affected NEW or USED 2021 CBR1000RR-R (SP) motorcycle until it is inspected, and repaired (if needed), according to the associated Service Bulletin.**

The 2021 CBR1000RR-R (SP) motorcycles included in the VIN range below are affected by the Stop Sale.

Customers will be informed their motorcycle may be affected by a safety related defect and will be advised to make an appointment with an authorized Honda powersports dealer for inspection and, if necessary, repair.
