Issue	Model \	Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2021 C-Class Convertible and E-Class Convertible (205 and 238 platform) vehicles, the mounting point of the rear headrests to the seatback might not meet specifications. In this case, the rear headrests might move or detach from the seat in the event of a crash. This could increase the risk of injury.			
What We're Doing		MBUSA will conduct a voluntary recall. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the guide bushings on the rear seatbacks of the potentially affected vehicles and replace them, if necessary.

Mercedes-Benz AG ("MBAG"), the manufacturer of Mercedes-Benz vehicles, has determined that on certain Model Year ("MY") 2021 C-Class Convertible and E-Class Convertible (205 and 238 platform) vehicles, the mounting point of the rear headrests to the seatback might not meet specifications. In this case, the rear headrests might move or detach from the seat in the event of a crash. This could increase the risk of injury. An authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer will check the guide bushings on the rear seatbacks of the potentially affected vehicles and replace them, if necessary.

Prior to performing this Recall Campaign:

- VMI must always be checked before performing campaigns to verify that the campaign is required on a specific vehicle. Always check for any other open campaigns, and perform accordingly.
- Please review the entire Recall Campaign bulletin and follow the repair procedure exactly as described.

Please note that Recall Campaigns **do not expire** and may also be performed on a vehicle with a vehicle status indicator.

Check head restraint guides on rear head restraints and replace if necessary Models 205 and 238

Check/test procedure

- 1. Fold both seat backrests in the rear passenger compartment forward.
- 2. Check head restraint guide sleeves on the underside of **both head restraints in the rear passenger compartment**.
 - A head restraint guide sleeve with a locking clip and release lever must be installed in the direction of travel on the right side of each head restraint (A, Figure 1).
 - i In each case, the locking clip (B, Figure 1) must point toward the right side of the vehicle.
 - In each case, the release lever (C, Figure 1) must point toward the left side of the vehicle.
 - i Guide sleeves without a lock must be installed in the direction of travel on the left side of the head restraints.



- a. Head restraint guide sleeve or sleeves twisted or installed on the wrong side: Carry out work procedure.
- **b**. Head restraint guide sleeves installed **correctly: End measure**.

Work procedure

1. Replace incorrectly installed head restraint guide sleeves (AR91.16-P-1776LWR)

Between 1 and 4 head restraint guide sleeves may be required
