Background			
Issue	Mercedes-Benz AG (MBAG) has determined that the software of the MBUX multimedia system might not meet specifications. Under very specific conditions, the MBUX multimedia system might not start and the display might remain black, or could reboot unintentionally after 50 seconds of initial startup.  Accordingly, the rearview camera image might not be displayed or the display might be interrupted which could increase a risk of a crash or injury.		
What We're Doing	MBUSA is conducting a voluntary recall. Either an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer or an over-the-air ("OTA") update will update the MBUX software on the affected vehicles.		
Remedy	Software is not yet available. An additional notification will be sent once the remedy is available.
