IMPORTANT NOTE ON PARTS SUPPLY AND USAGE:

Part # 85575854 Rear Suspension Link Assembly is in very limited supply and will be replaced by a new service part in the very near future. DO NOT order this part for shelf stock in your inventory, this is a field fix part for customer-owned vehicles only at this time. These parts should be only utilized for customers who have experienced one or more of the described warning signs relating to the loose toe link condition, or whose vehicle is otherwise determined to have the condition.

Warnings may include:

- Service Traction Control message
- Service Stabilitrak message
- Stabilitrak malfunction indicator lamp (MIL) stays on or flashes intermittently
- Service Rear Axle message
- Chimes in combination with any of these messages or MILs
- Sway or wander while driving
- Loud metallic or other unusual noise from the rear suspension
- Off-center steering wheel
- Uneven wear between the rear tires

A customer who experiences these warnings should have the vehicle flat towed to a GM dealership and should not drive the vehicle until it is inspected by a GM dealer.

Involved vehicles in used dealer inventory should remain on stop delivery until the new service part is released.

Saab vehicles should be repaired by the GM dealer under this recall. They will not be serviced at official Saab Service Centers.
