Issue:	The pressure input rod connection on the brake booster may not have been tightened correctly to factory specifications. If the pressure input rod detaches from the brake booster, the brake pedal will not work correctly to stop the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash. The driver can still utilize the electric parking brake to stop the vehicle.					
Repair:	 REPAIR AVAILABLE – September 21, 2021 / Inspect and, if necessary, tighten the affected screw to the proper value. See ELSA/ServiceNet for complete repair & claiming instructions Check both the daily Campaign Open Inventory report <u>and</u> OMD for affected vehicles in inventory. Verify OPEN status in ELSA <u>on the day of repair</u>. Repair every affected inventory vehicle <u>before delivery to consumers</u>.
