Subject: Safety Recall SC432, ZF Power Steering Pump

Recall Number: SRA-M432

Description

On certain trucks, a defect in the power steering pump could cause it to leak power steering fluid. If this happens, there could be a loss of power steering assist.

A loss of power steering assist may result in a sudden increase in steering effort, especially at low speeds. This could increase the risk of a crash.

The power steering pumps will be replaced on the vehicles.

Model and Model Years Affected

 Certain Mack 2021 Granite and LR model vehicles manufactured from June 15, 2020 through September 16, 2020.

Dealer Responsibilities

- The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires
 dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant

- Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle
 included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before
 releasing it to a customer.
