

# MACK TRUCKS RECALL ALERT

**Subject:** Safety Recall SC433, Park Brake Control Valve  
**Recall Number:** SRA-M433  
**Date:** December 17, 2021  
**Applicable Markets:**  U.S.  Canada  Export

## **Description**

A worn PP1 valve (park brake control valve) exhibiting an internal leak may cause air to pass through and out the exhaust port when the park brake is applied. Under certain conditions, the internal leak in combination with the installation of an exhaust hose may result in back pressure sufficient to allow the park brakes to release.

This results in a potential of a vehicle rollaway with the park brake control valve in the on/applied position, which may result in a vehicle crash, property damage and/or personal injury.

The exhaust tube and fitting will be removed from the valve. With the exhaust tube removed, a notable rush of air may now be heard from behind the dash during park brake apply. This is normal.

## **Model and Model Years Affected**

- Certain 2008 – 2022 Mack TerraPro (MRU, TE) model vehicles manufactured from January 4, 2007 through December 6, 2021.

## **Vehicle Quantities**

- 23,473 (20,668 US, 2,624 Canada, 181 Export)

## **Dealer Responsibilities**

- The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act require dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.
- Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

- Vehicle list will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal on December 17, 2021
- Owner notification letters will be released on or before February 4, 2022
