Autocar, LLC has determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in 251, 2021-2022 model year Xpeditor chassis manufactured between November 2, 2020, and June 16, 2021, with non-sequential serial numbers between 234753 and 236329, accordingly, a recall to address this issue is being initiated effective February 10, 2022.
