## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: Safety Recall 21PBA - Model 320/520 Steering Column Support

Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model 320/520 Right Hand Stand-Up (RHSU) vehicles manufactured between June 26, 2014 and November 17, 2020. The steering column support structure may crack or break. Cracks may develop in the formed steel tube as a result of forces applied to the bracket from pulling on the steering wheel or using the steering wheel as a grab handle. If the steering column loosens from the mounting structure, steering control can become affected, increasing the risk of a crash.

What is the problem? The steering column support may crack or break

What will your dealer do? Your dealer will inspect for cracks in the structure and, if necessary, replace the RHSU steering column

structure. Additional support brackets will be added even if no cracks are present.

What should you do? Contact your dealer to schedule the repair.

Peterbilt Motors Company has initiated this recall to remedy the issue at no charge to you. Please contact your Peterbilt dealer to schedule an appointment for these services. When contacting your Peterbilt dealer, reference the Safety Recall number and the NHTSA number. This repair may take up to 2 hours of labor depending on dealer scheduling.

If you had this repair performed before receiving this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. Receipts for parts and/or labor are required for consideration of reimbursement, Contact your local Peterbilt dealership for details.
