This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Life Line Emergency Vehicles (Life Line) is recalling certain vehicles on which Code3 7x9 Stop-Tail-Turn-Reverse All-in-One LED Lamps are installed.

Life Line Emergency Vehicles was notified that the subject lamps exceed the maximum permissible candela levels specified in Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 108 at certain test points.

There have been no known complaints, accidents or injuries related to this noncompliance

We have included a letter from ECCO Holdings Corp. that identifies the recall. The remedy is currently under development.
