Subject: Safety Recall 21PBE - TSE Brake Chamber Air Leak

This notice applies to your vehicle. Your VIN(s) can be found on the bottom or back of this page.

Dear Peterbilt Customer,

You are receiving this notice in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety may exist in certain Model 579 and 348 vehicles manufactured from 03/11/2020 through 07/13/2020 with Meritor rear disc brakes.

Certain TSE brake chambers were built with a mis-aligned park spring, which may cause a fatigue hole in the diaphragm and an internal air leak. The leak could drain the air system pressure, causing brake drag and setting the parking brakes, increasing the risk of a crash or injury.

What is the problem?	Meritor rear disc brakes built with TSE brake chambers could leak air.
What will your dealer do?	The dealer will replace all rear brake chambers.
What should you do?	Contact your dealer to schedule the repair.

Peterbilt Motors Company has initiated this recall to remedy the issue with no charge to you. Please contact your Peterbilt dealer to schedule an appointment for these services. To find your Peterbilt dealer, please visit the Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com or scan the QR code. When contacting your Peterbilt dealer, reference the Safety Recall number and the NHTSA number. This repair may take up to 2 hours of labor depending on dealer scheduling.

If you had this repair performed before receiving this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. Receipts for parts and/or labor are required for consideration of reimbursement. Contact your local Peterbilt dealership for details.
